Be creative and paint away! **Craft tip:** it may be helpful to flip the pot upside down so that you can have easier access to all sides.



Poke a small hole in the centre of the pot using your finger about one inch deep, or up to your second knuckle.





Once you are finished painting the pot, set it aside to dry.



Then drop one sunflower seed in the hole. Cover the seed with the soil, add a little bit of water and watch it grow!



When the paint is dry, add soil to the pot filling it to the top!



Don't forget to water your sunflower seed as it grows! Try planting the additional seeds directly in your garden in mid-May to late June.
