- Wool
- Coloured felt pieces
- A button nose
- Googly eyes
- White glue
- Liquid hand soap
- A bowl of warm water
- Scissors

Felted Farmyard Friends





Roll the wool into a ball, making sure to keep the edges tucked in.




Add some soap to your hand and wet the ball of wool with warm water (so it is damp but not dripping).



Gently roll the wool between the palms of your hands for 3-5 minutes until the wool has become a solid ball. Ask an adult to help, making sure it is rolled in a tight and compact ball.



Use a hand towel to dry the felted ball or use a hair dryer.



Using the felt pieces, cut out two ears from each colour (and a nose for the dog).



Finally, use white glue to give your Farmyard Friends their faces.
